The Police and Crime Commissioner is asked to:

Approve the bid for an expansion of the Sheffield Policing District vehicle fleet by one response car at a cost of £37,000 capital (2019/20) and a 3 year fleet revenue cost of £18,100 per annum from 2020/21.

Executive Summary of Request	Supporting Report attached?	No
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This bid is to fund the increase of the response car resources in Sheffield district from 2 to 3. Due to the geographical size of the district and the number of immediate incidents received, the additional capacity would improve the balance of resource to demand.

The first year cost is limited to capital for VFM to purchase the vehicle there will be a recurrent cost to the district in terms of lease charges. No fuel costs are included due to annual underspend on this budget code.

In particular this resource enables quicker response to crime and incidents requiring us to protect vulnerable people. It provides a development corridor for our talent providing an aspirational goal of advance driving and enables us to use our resources - vehicle and people well.

The main benefits:

- **increased capability to attend emergency graded incidents will increase**
- **significantly reduce response times to outer areas of the district**
- **offers enhanced tactical options in terms of intelligence and initial pursuits**
- **provision of additional resource with enhanced skills/options e.g. TASER/FIT/MOE/TRACKER**
- **increased public and staff safety**
- **positive reputational impact in terms of visibility of a high powered response vehicle in the community**
