Freedom of Information Request - Reference No: 1275

REQUEST

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, [REDACTED] requests that the South Yorkshire Police Crime Commissioner produce a list of the titles (for documents without a title a brief document description) & creation dates of all documents or data received from South Yorkshire Police, sent to the Commissioner Office or Advisory Panel on Policing Protests for the review into the policing of tree protests in Sheffield.

If any document or portion thereof is claimed to be exempt from production under FOI, sufficient identifying information (with respect to each allegedly exempt document or portion thereof) must be provided to allow the assessment of the propriety of the claimed exemption.

If any communication (email, telephone records, letter, memo, opinions, or any other means of conveying thought) between South Yorkshire Police and South Yorkshire Police Crime Commissioner's Office occurs from the date this request is submitted til complete, related to the documents requested in any way, provide the full document, or description thereof.

RESPONSE

The office of the South Yorkshire Police and Crime Commissioner holds information relating to the information you have requested. However, information relating to your request is available on the Commissioner's website.

When refusing to provide information directly, because an exemption is engaged, Section 17 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 requires the OPCC to provide the applicant, with a notice which:

- a. states that fact,
- b. specifies the exemption in question and
- c. states (if that would not otherwise be apparent) why the exemption applies.

In this instance, **Section 21 – 'Information reasonably accessible by other means'** is engaged, because information is published on the website.

Please see response to FOI 1245 which provides documents, communications and details that were used to create the report on the Sheffield Tree Protests.
