Decision Requested

The Police and Crime Commissioner is asked to:

Permit the use of the SU5000 Safety Camera Partnership (SRP) grant brought forward from 2019/20 , a sum of £42,200 be used for capital investment in hand held speed camera enforcement equipment for use by South Yorkshire Safety Cameras and district officers at community concern sites throughout South Yorkshire.

The operating budget of South Yorkshire Safety Cameras is set each year and is funded through Highways England contributions and Driver Behaviour Course Referral cost recovery.

At the end of the 2019/20 financial year there was a remaining budget on the SRP grant carried forward from previous years of £42,200. This was carried forward with the intention of using it to invest in speed enforcement at sites that are considered to be of community concern.

The number of community concern sites has risen rapidly during the current pandemic. This has resulted in over 60 sites currently being assessed for high profile periodic speed enforcement action to increase community confidence in South Yorkshire Police and Safety Cameras ability to tackle these issues.

Through such action we will endeavour to achieve a resolution to the perceived and actual problems of excessive speed and anti-social driving within those communities and protect vulnerable road users.

Community speed watch activity has been suspended during this pandemic due to the existing and ongoing Covid restrictions. This has left communities feeling vulnerable to both perceived and actual increased traffic speeds.

South Yorkshire Safety Cameras is working to increase the capability to carry out such speed enforcement and collaborate with Local Neighbourhood Teams at all Districts. Enabling PCSO's and District officers to carry out speed enforcement in their respective

communities in addition to the work of South Yorkshire Safety Cameras.

Such collaboration was discussed in part with the Police and Crime Commissioner at a recent meeting to discuss such community speed issues in the Doncaster and surrounding areas and expanding this force wide.

Approval by proposer (SLG lead / OPCC SMG lead) and confirmation request is ready for PCC consideration

As considered and approved at the Strategic Resourcing Board on 22nd December 2020 for onward submission to the oPCC.


