<p>The Police and Crime Commissioner is asked to:</p> <p>Approve the purchase for a replacement off road bike from the OSU grant. SU5039 – Off Road Bikes Councils c/f 19/20 £11,027</p> <p>The cost for a replacement Yamaha off road bike (same as those in the rest of the fleet) is £7,261.00 to purchase and commission (advised by VFM).</p> <p>This requires PCC approval because it is direct revenue financing (Financial Regulations Section 6 paragraph 1)</p>

<p>To replace an off road motorcycle (existing asset), that was originally grant funded, which has sustained mechanical damage, assessed by the Vehicle Fleet Management (VFM) technicians as beyond economical repair. The bike engine had blown and a replacement engine unavailable.</p> <p>This is to ensure that the current off road fleet capacity is maintained for effective operational deployments in tackling community priorities relating to off road bike complaints, organised crime and criminal use of the roads.</p> <p>The off road bike team is a force-wide resource tackling:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Issues that matter most to our communities, namely off road bike complaints, antisocial use of motorcycles • The criminal use of motorcycles and organised crime. • Rural and wildlife related crime issues. <p>The grant SU5039 – off road bikes has been carried forward and there are no issues preventing this grant from being carried over into 2021/22 (revenue to capital) because the bike is expected to be purchased early in Q1 2021/22 due to vehicle ordering timescales.</p>




