<p>The Police and Crime Commissioner (“The Commissioner”) is recommended to approve recommendations made by the April 2021 Community Grant Scheme Panel.</p>		
<b>Executive Summary of Request</b>	<b>Supporting Report attached?</b>	<b>No</b>
<p>The Commissioner's Proceeds of Crime Act (POCA) Community Grant Scheme for 2021/22 enables non-profit organisations to apply for funding of up to £7,500. Proposed activities must address one or more of the Commissioner strategic priorities as set out in the Police &amp; Crime Plan. Funded organisations have to show compliance with Terms &amp; Conditions including the submission of monitoring Information upon completion of their project.</p> <p>Officers have considered and assessed 28 applications for funding with a total value of £170,811 and recommend that 7 applications be approved.</p> <p>A meeting was held on the 30<sup>th</sup> April 2021 (via Microsoft Teams due to the Covid-19 situation) with the PCC to discuss the applications and panel recommendations. A decision was made to fund the grants set out below.</p> <p>Ten bids were agreed to be funded with a total value of £56,767</p>

Each of the recommended projects will be provided with a grant agreement specific to this fund. All projects will be required to submit monitoring information upon completion of their project. It is proposed that 50% of the grant is paid in advance with the final payment made at the end of the project based on actual expenditure, should this cause an issue for any of the organisations an alternative payment schedule can be negotiated. Following consultation with the OPCC Finance Manager it is agreed that payments will be signed off using the pro-forma method.

All grant recipients will be subject to due diligence checks prior to the release of funding.

Approval by proposer (SLG lead / OPCC SMG lead) and confirmation request is ready for PCC consideration

The Community Grants Scheme budget for 2021/22 is £150,000, there is sufficient budget within this to cover the recommended grants.
