Decision Requested

This Decision Form is accompanied by contract change request CCN43 and has been provided to amend the Criminal Justice Replacement System Contract (reference 2013-680) for both South Yorkshire & Humberside Police. The Humberside element of the contract lapsed on 30th June 2022.

Humberside Police are contractually and legally obligated to access the South Yorkshire System in respect of the data held to maintain the quality of the data. If approval is granted for the change request, the PCC is asked to sign the document on page 3 to enable read only access for Humberside Police to the solution.

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Background

In 2015 South Yorkshire and Humberside Police entered into a joint contract with NEC Software Solutions UK Ltd (formerly Northgate Public Services (UK) Ltd for the provision of a fully integrated Criminal Justice and Investigation Records Management System. The Humberside element of the contract lapsed on 30th June 2022, however, in order to access the system, Humberside Police require 150 “read only” licenses to maintain the integrity of said data.

Matter for Consideration

Regional Procurement were approached on 15th November 2022 by IT to request the above named change be incorporated into the contract by the PCC. The change incorporates 150 “Read Only” licenses for Humberside Police to access the Connect Software and the data held within for a 12-month period, or up until the point NEC remove the Humberside Police data from their solution. The following costs apply to this change:


- First payment: 6 months access = £30,600
- 6x remaining monthly payments = 6 x £5,100
- Total: £61,200

The above named costs have been scrutinised by Humberside Police and considered reasonable and proportionate for the services required. Humberside have agreed to fund this change request in its entirety and budget has been confirmed by ACO Chris Philpott.


The documentation is therefore submitted to the OPCC for signature in line with Contract Standing Orders.

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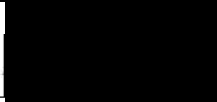
